

Stewards Required for National Feast of Lanterns 2011

Steve Cash Chief Camp Steward for NFOL 2011 is seeking groups of three units/friends to steward areas at the NFOL 2011.

We are bringing the area stewards in at the same time as the working party

You will be camped together at the entrance to your area and we would encourage you to work out of your awnings, use party tents or gazebos as places to get together while undertaking your duties as stewards.

We try to be flexible with time commitments but really need you and your team to be available most of the week to complete the setting up of your area.

You will need to think about costumes or some form of identification so the members will recognise your team.

Your efforts will be rewarded with a full week of evening entertainment including an invitation to the working party party, a complementary working party pennon and entry into the exclusive working party prize-draw.

Your duties will include arriving one week prior to the event to familiarize yourselves to your area and the agreed pitching arrangements

You will be asked to:-

1. Support the pegging teams to peg out the pitches and directional signs according to the area plans
2. Decorate and illuminate the entrance to your area in the Best of British theme.
3. Collect in pegs and other paraphernalia throughout the rally
4. Leave row numbers in situ till the last moment so members can be found if necessary

You will be issued with a stewarding kit, radio, tea and coffee and details of the number of individual units and block bookings planned for your area,

During the NFOL you will need to organise a steward's rota between the members of your team to ensure there is always someone available to be of assistance to any member who needs help. Overnight you will be asked to leave an emergency contact number outside your unit for members to use should they need help out of hours.

When campers arrive....

No matter what time we agree as an opening time members traditionally arrive early so you will need to be up early and ready to receive them as they arrive throughout the day. Whenever they arrive each family should be welcomed warmly, Please be especially supportive to those members who are disabled or the frail elderly; those who are new to this style of camping and those who just need help.

A member of your team should be on hand in the fields to offer support and guidance as they site their units directing them to the nearest elsan, water and other facilities.

The Steward must be prepared to take control in any emergency until the arrival of the Emergency Officer or the Emergency Service, whose particular tasks include a responsibility for the type of emergency concerned.

Remember you are there to make sure that the event runs smoothly and safely for everybody.
